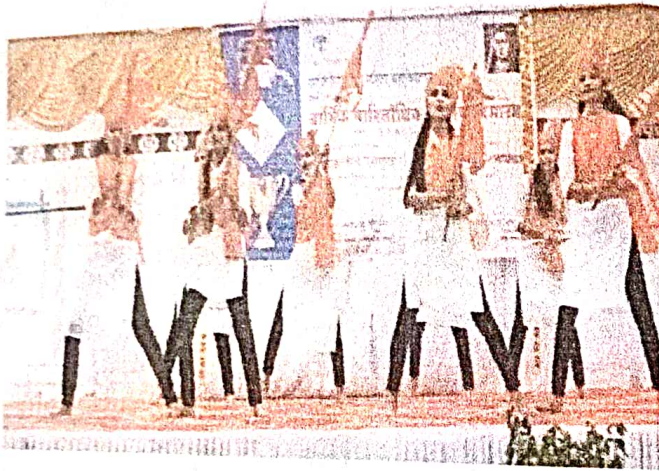

Outcomes:- Student get opportunity to show their gratitude towards the teachers. They understand duties and work of teachers.



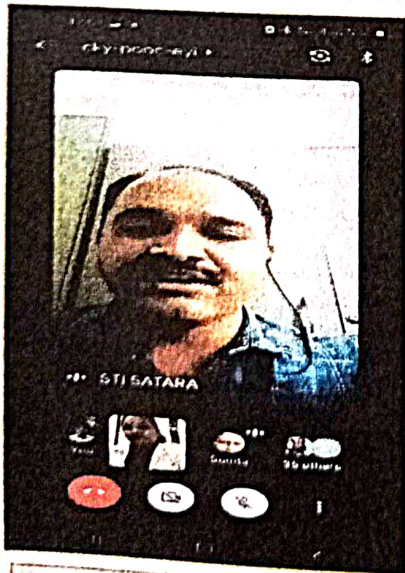

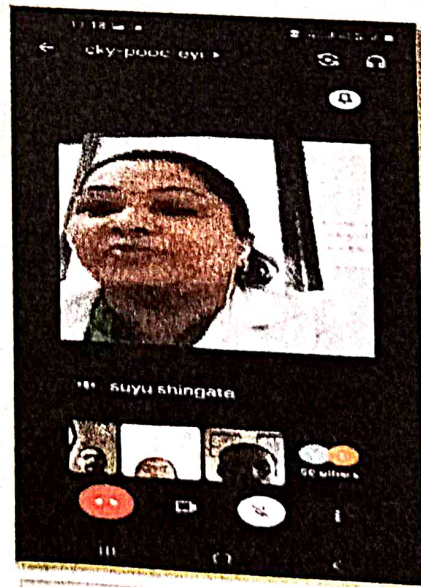
Objective:- To create awareness regarding comprehensive care, support and treatment to all persons living with HIV/AIDS.

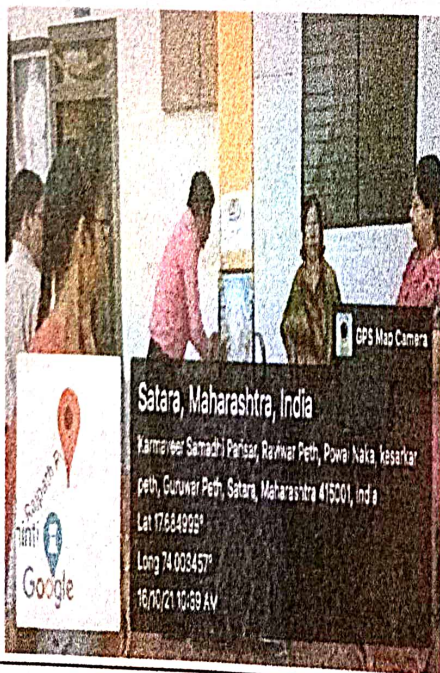
