Description of the Activity:-

Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's, Savitribai Phule Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Satara IQAC and Department of psychology and Health Club jointly organized extension activity on **Tuberculosis Awareness programme at Jihe (Kathapur)** village nearby Satara on 13th April 2022.

Dr.Jayashri Aphale IQAC coordinator felicitated the Head of the village: Mrs. and Dr.Sanjay Phadtare ,the president of the programme and members of village. Dr. Mrs. Jayashri Aphale explained the students and villagers about the objective of the extension activity. Moreover she informed them about the different symptoms of tuberculosis and treatment given to cure from it .The nurses from the local health centre also joined in this activity. The resource person Ms.Pooja Bhatiya, assistant professor from Zoology department, Y C Institute of Science, Satara guided thoroughly about tuberculosis. She explained in detail the various reasons for tuberculosis and also informed the participants how to avoid T.B. with some precautions and cleanliness. She also instructed people about the initiatives to be taken for own health and steps of TB and its treatment process. Dr.Sanjay Phadtare appreciated the efforts of college to create the awareness about TB among the people. He also extended his helping hand towards the villagers and instructed them not to conceal the disease. Then the question-answer session was held .All

the participants became satisfied due to the answers. After the guidance and question answer session the health check —up process was done by the students from B.Voc in Nursing Department and local Health Centre staff. Rapid sputum tests are made to find germs which can cause an infection, BP and Sugar are also checked as a part of health precaution. Shri.Dilip Pawar compered the programme, Dr.Abhijeet Phate introduced the resource person and guests and Mrs.Smita kumbhar proposed the vote of thanks.
