Description of Activity:

Savitribai Phule Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Satara has organized a two day workshop on Revised SSR Framework and Documentation on 28th and 29th January, 2023. The workshop was opened with the welcome note by Prof. Dr. Sunita Gharge, Head Department of English in the inaugural session at 10.30 AM on 28th January, 2023. Dr.Mrs. Jayashri Aphale, Coordinator-IQAC and workshop introduced the keynote speaker, Hon. Dr. Jagannath Patil the Keynote speaker and Resource Person Hon.Prof.Dr.Ayub Shaikh.

After inauguration, Hon.Dr.Jagannath Patil, Advisor, NAAC Bangalore has joined for the Session-I through virtual Mode. In his keynote address he explained the vision and mission of NAAC. He discussed the Revised NAAC Framework, and explained in detail its objectives and Qualitative and Quantitative metrics of all 7 Criteria to the participants. He mentioned that NAAC has played vital role in the growth of the academic standard of institutions and

individuals across the nation. Dr.Mrs.Jayashri Aphale proposed the vote of thanks of Key note addressor Ho. Dr. Jagnnath Patil. On 12 pm the core session was started with the Criterion –I. He explained in detail the criterion wise qualitative and quantitative metrics and DVV. In very simple and lucid manner Dr.Ayub Shaikh explained the documentation process and documents required. On the first day Criteria I to III wrer explained. On the first day, programme was thanked by Mrs.Latika Patil ,Co-coordinator of workshop.

The second and concluding day started with Criterion No .IV Hon.Prof.Dr.Ayub Shaikh gave a detailed guidance on revised SSR framework for achieving well score and grade for the institutions. He enabled the participants to understand the mistakes happened during their SSR preparation, submission and DVV process and same time he guided how to overcome them with proper measures. All seven Criteria were explained by showing excellent PowerPoint presentation. The doubts of participants were cleared by Keynote Speaker during question-answer session.

The workshop was concluded with the **valedictory session** at 3.30 PM on 29th January, 2023. Prin. Dr.Arun Andhale, Bharatratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Mahavidyalaya, Aundh, Pune was the Chief Guest.
