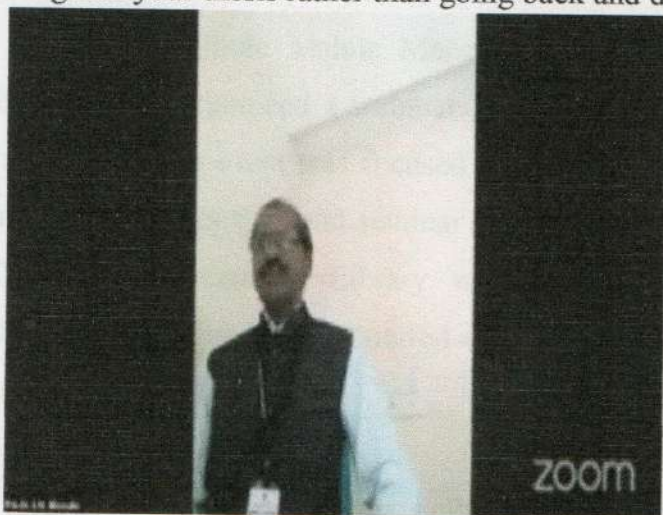

He also mentioned about different errors made by students while writing project reports and gave useful tips on how to avoid them.

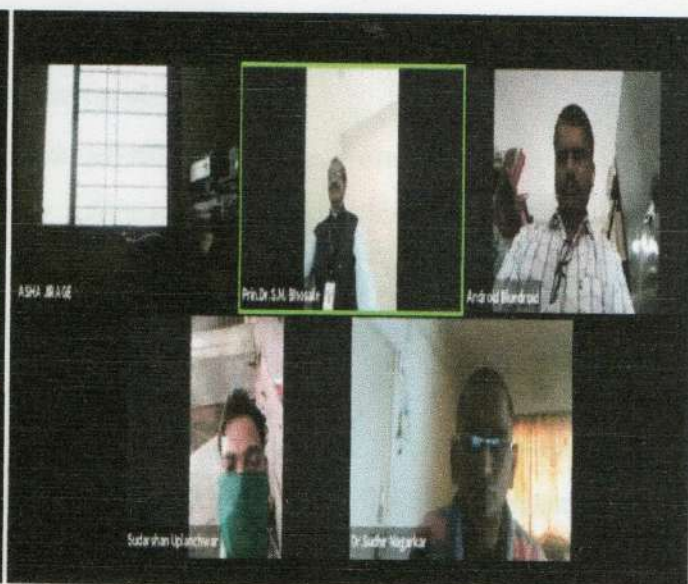

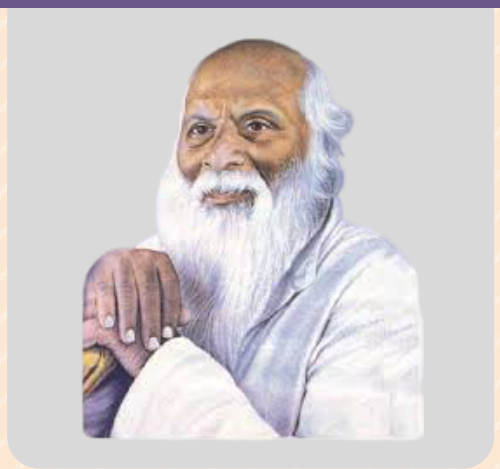

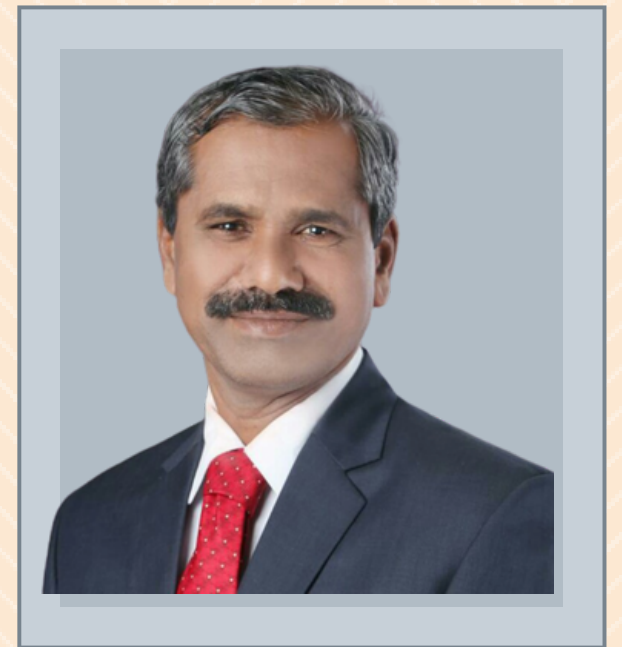
